Subject: Appointment of Managing Director for Special Purpose Vehicle (SPVs) of Belagavi and Davangere.

PREAMBLE:-

The Government of India (GoI) has launched the Smart Cities Mission (SCM) on 25.06.2015. The objective of the Mission is to improve quality of life of its citizens by providing core infrastructure, a clean and sustainable environment and application of 'Smart' Solutions. The mission will cover 100 cities and its duration will be five years (2015-16 to 2019-2020).

The Government of Karnataka (GoK) has accorded approval for implementation of Smart Cities Scheme in the State vide Government order read at (2) above. The High Power Steering Committee (HPSC) for Smart Cities Scheme has been also constituted under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary with representatives of various State Government departments to guide the mission in the State.

The Karnataka Urban Infrastructure Development & Finance Corporation (KUIDFC) has been nominated as the State Level Nodal Agency (SLNA) and Mission Directorate vide Government order read at (2) above. The High Power Steering Committee (HPSC) had recommended selection of 6 cities, viz., Belagavi, Shivamogga, Mangaluru, Hubballi Dharwad, Tumakuru, Davanagere for development under the Smart Cities Scheme based on the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Urban Development (MoUD), GoI. Accordingly, MoUD has accorded approval for the said 6 cities of Karnataka under Smart Cities Scheme.

These 6 Smart Cities prepared their "Smart City Proposal (SCP)" for participation in the 'City Challenge' and submitted the same to MoUD with the recommendations of HPSC vide its meeting held on 11.12.2015. Of these, Davanagere and Belagavi cities have been selected by MoUD on 28 January, 2016.

The mission will be implemented as a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) spread over 5 years with an annual allocation of Rs.100.00 Crore each from GoI and GoK for each city and thus each city will get Rs.1000.00 Crore at the end of 5 years.

In the Government order read (3) above, the State Government has accorded approval for the establishment of Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) in Davanagere and Belagavi cities with an authorised share capital of Rs.500.00 Crore and initial paid up capital of Rs.200.00 Crore.


In the letter read (4) above, Managing Director, KUIDFC has submitted the proposal for appointment of Commissioners of Belagavi and Davangere City Corporations as Managing Directors of the SPVs of the respective cities till full time MDs are appointed.
