Preamble:

Government of India has declared Smart City Mission with an objective to upgrade 100 cities across the nation as 'Smart Cities'. Ahmedabad and Surat from Gujarat are amongst the 20 cities selected in the Phase-1 of the program. As stated in Smart City Mission and Guidelines, referred to as No.1 above, the Smart City Projects are to be implemented through a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) for each City. The equity contribution of the state Government and the concerned Urban Local Body should be equal and should together be in majority of the total paid-up capital of at least Rs.200 crores for each SPV as per the Point no. 10.4 of the Mission Statement and Guidelines. Surat Municipal Corporation has proposed the structure of SPV for the City of Surat vide their letter dated 15-02-2016 (referred to as No.2).

Resolution:

After careful consideration, Government of Gujarat has decided

- (i) that the composition of the Boards of Directors of the Special Purpose Vehicle to be established for Surat City would remain as under:
 - 1. Municipal Commissioner Chairperson
 - 2. Chairman of the Standing Committee Director
 - 3. City Engineer- Director
 - 4. Deputy Municipal Commissioner (F)- Director
 - 5. Deputy Municipal Commissioner (IIQ)- Director.



- 6. Deputy Municipal Commissioner (P & D)- Director
- 7. Dy. Municipal Commissioner (ISD)- Director
- 8. Central Government Nominee- Director . *
- Additional CEO-GUDM and State Mission Director Smart Cities as the nominee member of Government of Gujarat – Director
- 10. Managing Director/Chief Executive Officer- Director
- (ii) that the Grants/Project Money as may be provided by Government of Gujarat would be utilized as the Share Contribution from the State Government in the SPV and State Government's equity contribution is capped to the extent to the amount of such Grants/Project Money subject to the provisions of minimum share capital as prescribed in the Mission Statement and Guidelines. Arrangement of equity contribution can be made even with advance grants, if needed.
